


This feature is available to students once they begin a test.

- 1) Using the mouse click and drag the text one wants highlighted.
- 2) A highlight prompt will open.
- 3) Click on the prompt.
- 4) The default color is yellow, but there are three additional colors available if the student clicks on the down arrow.




